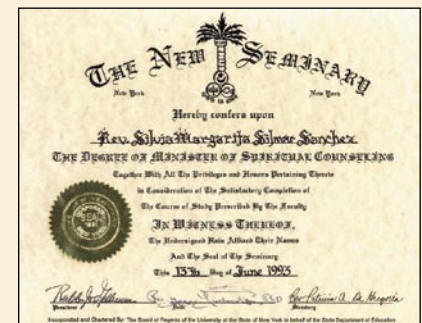

Reverend Silmar Sanchez is an interfaith minister. She was ordained in 1993 by The New Seminary, in a ceremony conducted in the Cathedral of St. John The Divine in New York City. Her training included two years of intensive studies and practicum at The New Seminary, a ministerial school that encompasses all of the world's major religions, faiths and peoples in its curriculum.

Rev. Sanchez is also a graduate of the University of South Florida (Tampa, FL) with a B.A. degree in Languages and Education. She has also completed graduate coursework in psychology and counseling practices from the University of Central Florida (Orlando, FL). State-certified as a ministerial counselor and as a pre-marital education provider in both New York and Florida, Rev. Sanchez has had 27 years of classroom teaching experience in middle schools, high schools and community colleges. She is fluent in both Spanish and English.
